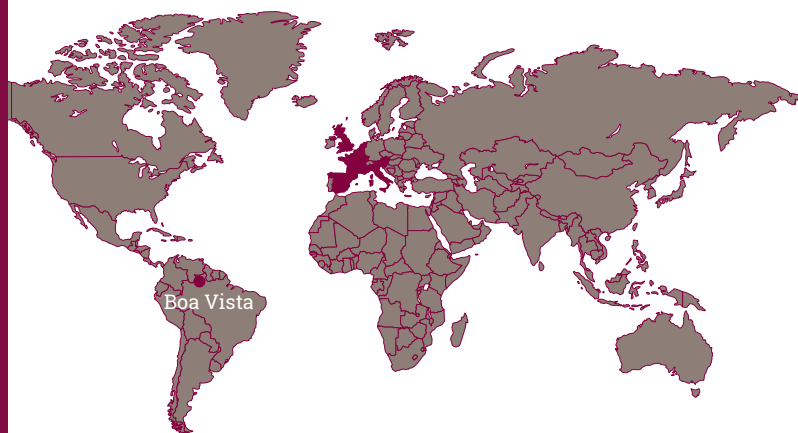




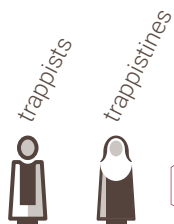

Authentic Trappist Product (ATP)

Any product that originates within the walls of a Trappist abbey is a Trappist® product. An abbey can go one step further by applying for the international quality label 'Authentic Trappist Product (ATP)'. Only abbeys that are members of the ITA (International Trappist Association) may apply for the label.

The ATP-label guarantees that a Trappist® product:

- is produced within or near the abbey;
- is produced under the supervision of monks or nuns;
- generates revenue for the monastic community, solidarity and charitable causes.

In addition to Trappist® beer, cheese, bread, liqueurs, chocolate and religious articles may also carry the label.
